





<p>Reflect on a story</p> <p>After reading a story, talk with your child about their favourite part of the story.</p> <p>Draw your favourite part & then have-a-go at writing about it.</p>	<p>Play a game of I-spy</p> <p>Play a game of I-spy using colours eg "I spy something the colour red" and build up to objects starting with the sounds s,a,t,p,l,n eg.</p> <p>"I spy something beginning with the "ssssss" sound.</p>	<p>Magazine letter hunt</p> <p>Cut out some letters from old magazine or newspapers and then draw something that starts with that letter.</p> <p>To make it more interesting play a guessing game to match the picture to the letter.</p>	<p>Play Simon Says</p> <p>Start with 1 step instructions e.g. "Simon says put your hands on your head" and build up to 3 or 4 steps "Simon says touch your head, then your nose and the hop on 1 leg."</p>	<p>READ</p> <p>Choose a book & try to guess what the story is about just by looking at the cover. Then read the story & predict what happens next.</p>
<p>Make a story</p> <p>Make up a story just by using the pictures in the book.</p>  <p>I wonder how different your story will be?</p>	<p>Rainbow writing</p> <p>Write your name with 5 different colours. Rainbow write the high frequency words– to, a, is, it, I, the.</p>	<p>DRAW</p> <p>Draw a picture and send it to a friend or relative via the mail.</p> 	<p>Sound Waves</p> <p>Using a I-pad or computer</p> <p>https://online.fireflyeducation.com.au/services/student_login/soundwaves</p> <p>then login using the access code rich762 & let your child have a play.
