What can you hear?</p>	<p>GET NOISY</p> <p>Make loud sounds, make quiet sounds. Bang on things and listen to the sounds.</p> 	<p>SYLLABLES</p> <p>Clap syllables in your name, family names, toys, animals, household objects.</p>	<p>READ</p> <p>Read a story, predict what happens next.</p> 
<p>READ</p> <p>Read a story just from the pictures.</p> 	<p>READ</p> <p>Read a story and talk about what happened. Could you tell the story differently.</p>	<p>DRAW</p> <p>Draw a picture and send it to a friend or relative via the mail.</p>	<p>WRITE</p> <p>Get someone to type out an email to a friend or relative.</p>	<p>DRAW</p> <p>Draw with chalk on the footpath.</p>
<p>SING</p> <p>Listen to nursery rhymes, sing a song.</p> 	<p>ACT IT OUT</p> <p>Act out a favourite story. Give it a different ending.</p>	<p>READ</p> <p>Share a story just for fun!</p> 	<p>WATCH</p> <p>Watch a movie. Talk about the characters, settings, events.</p>	<p>MAKE IT UP</p> <p>Place a special toy in a tree outside. Tell a story about how it got there. How long will it stay? What will it do?</p>
