Ask a grown up if you can find a recipe and bake something yummy.</p>	<p>SING</p> <p>Sing a song you know. Learn a new song and sing it loudly in the back yard.</p> 	<p>DISHES</p> <p>Ask a grown up if you can help to wash the dishes. You might like to give your toys a wash too!</p>	<p>COOK</p> <p>Ask a grown up to help you make a sandwich. You decide what you would like to put in it.</p>
<p>MENU</p> <p>Plan a menu for the meals for the week. Think about all of the ingredients you will need.</p>	<p>PLANT</p> <p>See if you have some seeds at your house that you could plant. Could you plant the seeds from an apple you ate? How about a plum?</p>	<p>GARDENING</p> <p>Water the lawn, rake up some leaves (and then jump in them!)</p> 	<p>PETS</p> <p>Help to feed your pets. Do they need some water? Could you give them a bath?</p>	<p>BUBBLES and PAINT</p> <p>Blow some bubbles outside. Make some bubbly water. If you have some paint at home, paint a picture.</p>
<p>MUSIC</p> <p>Make some music with things you find in the kitchen.</p> 	<p>PASS THE PARCEL</p> <p>Wrap up a toy with different paper and play Pass the Parcel.</p>	<p>DRESS UP</p> <p>Ask a grown up if you can put on some of their clothes for fancy dress.</p>	<p>SHADOWS</p> <p>Make shadows with your body or toys. Draw chalk on the pavement or trace around the shadows on a piece of paper.</p>	<p>VIDEO</p> <p>Send a video to your favourite relative (or to your teacher!) about what you have done for the day/wek.</p>
