Our first look at the 2021 data is positive and I thank the teachers for working so hard with all students to improve their learning outcomes.

### TRAFFIC WARDEN

I want to reassure parents that both the School Board and I are working hard to find a solution to this problem and continually raise the issue with the Police Department, asking them to employ a replacement.
