

**S**uccess **T**eamwork **R**espect **I**nnovation **V**oice and **E**mpathy



## NAPLAN

NAPLAN is a national literacy and numeracy assessment that students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 sit in May each year. It is the only national assessment all Australian students do. As students' progress through their school years, it's important to check how well they are learning the essential skills of reading, writing and numeracy.

NAPLAN assesses the literacy and numeracy skills that students are learning through the school curriculum and allows parents/carers to see how their child is progressing against national standards and over time. It is just one aspect of a school's assessment and reporting process and doesn't replace ongoing assessments made by teachers about student performance. It can provide teachers with additional information about students' progress. Students sit assessments in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. Questions assess content linked to the Australian Curriculum: English and Mathematics.

The tests are primarily done online, with our Year 3 students completing their writing assessment on paper. Online NAPLAN tests provide more precise results and are more engaging for students. One of the main benefits is tailored (or adaptive) testing, where the test presents questions which may be more or less difficult depending on a student's responses. Tailored testing allows a wider range of student abilities to be assessed and measures student achievement more precisely.

NAPLAN is for everyone. ACARA supports inclusive testing so all students can participate in the national assessment program. Adjustments are available for students with disability who have diverse functional abilities and needs. Parents who have questions, are concerned about NAPLAN or are considering withdrawing their child from NAPLAN can contact Mr Dickinson to discuss this on 9068-5300. Students in Years 3 and 5 brought home an information sheet about NAPLAN this week to give parents and caregivers information about NAPLAN.


