2024 KINDY ENROLMENTS

Kindy enrolments for 2024 are now open!

If you have a child born between 01.07.2019 and 30.06.2020 they are eligible to attend Kindergarten in 2024. Please call into the office at Hannans PS and collect an Application for Enrolment.

Western Australia now has immunisation laws that will help to better protect our children and the wider community from vaccine-preventable diseases.

When you enrol your child in Kindergarten you will need to provide your child's current Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement, which shows your child is 'up-to-date' with all the scheduled immunisations (according to the National Immunisation Program) for their age. This Statement must be no more than 2 months old.

Enrolment remains open until Friday 21 July 2023. After this time letters of offer will be sent out and once accepted you will be required to complete further paperwork. Play to Learn continues to operate on a Monday morning for students who will be attending Kindy in 2024.

TECH TALK

Hello Hannans PS Community

Welcome to Term 2. This term, as part of our *Tech Talk*, I would like to share ideas for you, as parents, to assist your family with managing technology at home. At times, technology can take over our lives, but it is important that we remember to take the time to talk to our children, read with our children and play with our children. Putting technology away can help with this.

One idea is to create a Family Technology Agreement or a fancier name, 'Fam Tec Pact' – a set of rules that can be displayed on the fridge where everyone will see them. Writing the rules together as a family is important and it will encourage the whole family to build good habits around technology. The most important thing to remember is that the agreement is not only for your children but also for you, as parents.

Here is an example of a simple agreement for when technology needs to be put away! Just one part of the agreement.
