Parent contributions that are collected are vital for the effective management of the school. Your contribution will allow the purchase of resources to supplement our school's teaching and learning programmes that directly benefit each student within the school, such as:

- *ICT – iPads/laptops, technology apps*
- *Resources such as reading books, maths equipment, library books, sports equipment*
- *School subscriptions e.g. Back to Front Maths, and Phonics Play*
- *Speech Pathology*
- *Occupational Therapy*
- *School events*

For your convenience the school operates a payment plan for parents wishing to make lump sum payments for their children. 2. **VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS**

3. **CHARGES**

These amounts can vary from year to year. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in the particular activity. The amounts indicated are the maximum for that activity.

4. **ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE IN THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

The cost for these items will vary from student to student.

- a. Individual requirements for all students. (eg booklists, library bag, tissues etc)
- b. Individual requirements recommended, but not essential.
- c. Individual requirements for selected students. (eg PEAC costs)

5. **OTHER FUNDRAISING COSTS**

Includes such things as P&C fundraising, Annual Lap-a-thon, free dress days, raffles etc.

6. **OPTIONAL COSTS – SUPPORTING OVERALL SCHOOL PURPOSE AND ETHOS**

Includes such things as Graduation shirts, VACSWIM vacation swimming, Scholastic Book Club, Student Council fundraising, Camp Fundraising, Master School Portraits (School photographs) etc.
