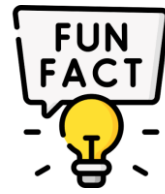

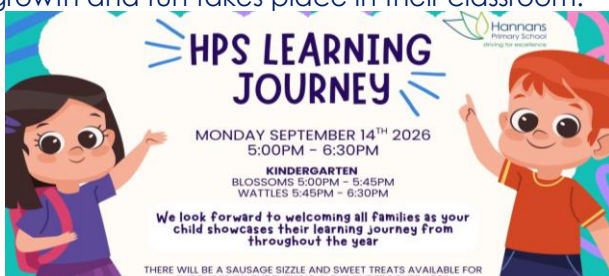
As with previous years, photos are able to be **ordered through the Compass Parent App** or online through the MSP webpage. There is a limited time to order without incurring a late fee. New students will be provided a shoot key on the day, or envelopes are available from the office.

We will again be offering for **families to have photos** taken prior to school. You must pre-pay and order through the parent app, be present with your children prior to school from 8:10am. Families with surnames A-M are on Thursday and N-Z on Friday. Siblings from other schools are welcome to be included, as are younger siblings.

Photos typically have about a six week turn around and are **delivered through the school**. They will be sent home with your child when they arrive. Any questions or late orders go directly through MSP.

Needed for each eligible child.
- ✓ **Student details**
Name at enrolment, date of birth, school name and year level.
- ✓ **Bank account details**
For the payment to be deposited.

Who can claim?

Parents and carers of WA students from Kindergarten to Year 12 with a valid WA student number.

How to claim

The fastest way is through the ServiceWA app. Alternative claim options will be available via the Department of Education website when needed.
